“HEART START” COURSE Wednesday 15th April at 7.30 in Midgley Community Room.



Local resident Jamie Harrop will be delivering a course on basic life saving skills for any person over 16 years of age who wishes to attend. The course will include advice on how to deal with someone who is choking, how to spot the signs and symptoms of a heart attack, how to treat serious bleeding, how to deal with an unconscious casualty, how to recognise a cardiac arrest and perform CPR and an introduction to public access defibrillators.

As well as being a qualified British Heart Foundation “Heart Start” trainer, Jamie is also a volunteer Community First Responder for Yorkshire Ambulance Service.

The course is free and lasts between one and a half to two hours but it will be restricted to 10 persons at a time. If numbers exceed 10 then places will be offered on a first come, first served basis for the 15th of April, but there will be a further course if required on Thursday 14th May.
