The Fete gets under way on Midgley Recreation Ground at 1.00 pm with Maypole dancing by Midgley school children, and continues with welly wanging, children's races, tug of war, straw races, and Midgley's famously chaotic terrier races (for large and small dogs of any description!)

This year sees the welcome return of the Fell Race with runners competing to be the first to Churn Milk Joan and back.

There's a chance for your dog to show off its best trick in the Tricky Dogs class and there's a lookalike competition for the dog who looks most like its handler.

All competitions and races can be entered on the day

Plenty of traditional stalls and games will provide fun for all ages, and there will be a range of food stalls as well as plants and local crafts.
